Our camping area is surrounded by National Park in a natural bush setting within close proximity to the northern end of Wario Beach. Our camping area has 2 sets of amenities blocks, laundry facilities, an undercover electric BBQ area, and an undercover washing up area with hot water. There is also a limited number of powered camping sites available (bookings are essential).

#### PEAK Holiday periods -

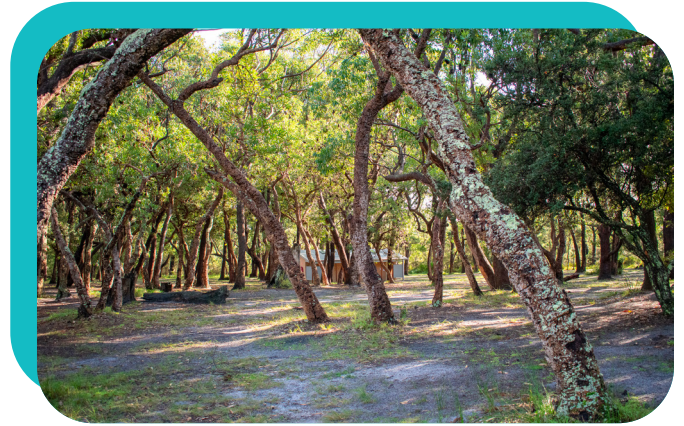
- Cancellations within 30 days Booking MUST be paid for in full. No refunds given within 30 days of cancellation.

# Burrill Pines Campground

## Camping Ground

- Our bush camping ground doesn't have allocated sites. Your campsite can be set up anywhere within the camp grounds.
- We run on a first in, first served basis.
- We cannot guarantee that you are next to your friend if you arrive at separate times.
- During peak periods, cars are to be parked outside camping area.
- We do not allow pets on site due to National Park guidelines.



## Camp Supplies

- Camp site is run on a septic system.
- Our facilities are connected to town water.
- Our showers are 2x 20c coins for 3 minutes of hot water. Monies can be exchanged for 20 cent coins at the office.
- We sell Lidcombe ice bags at the reception for \$5 for 5kgs.
- Hot and cold washing up area is located behind the campground amenities.
- Electric BBQ 2 x \$2 for 13mins of cooking

## Campfires

- Please bring a Fire Pit/Bucket if you wish to have a fire, All Fires are to be off the ground.
- Restrictions subject to weather conditions and total fire bans.
- Please do not source firewood from the campground area as the surrounding area is protected national park.
- We sell 20kg hardwood bags that are sourced from the local sawmill.
- To purchase firewood, see reception.  
Hardwood bags 1 for **\$25** or 2 for **\$40**
- Kindling \$15per bag

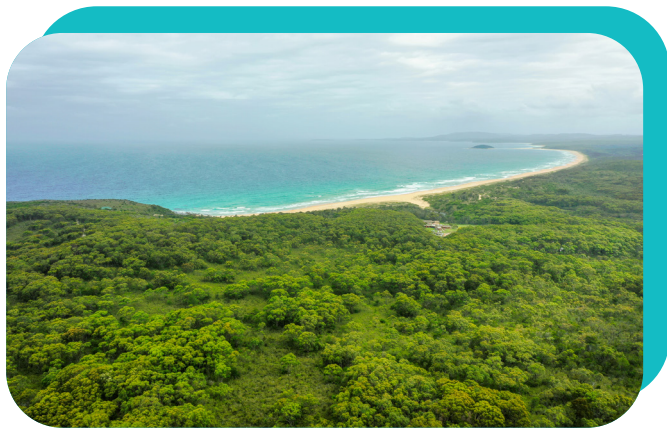
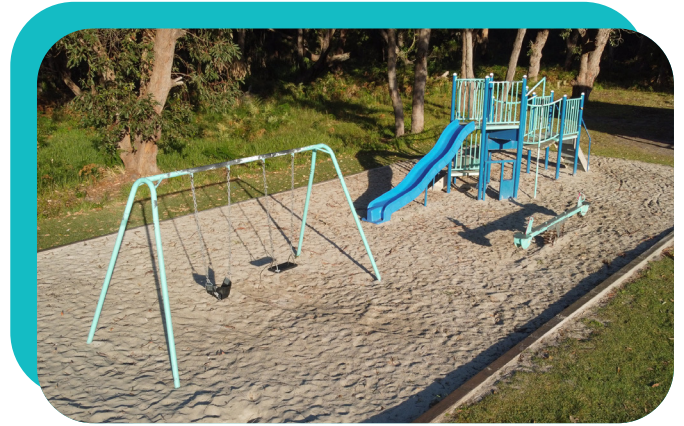




# Things to Do

# Conditions of Entry

## Burrill Pines Motel & Lagoon Point Conference Centre

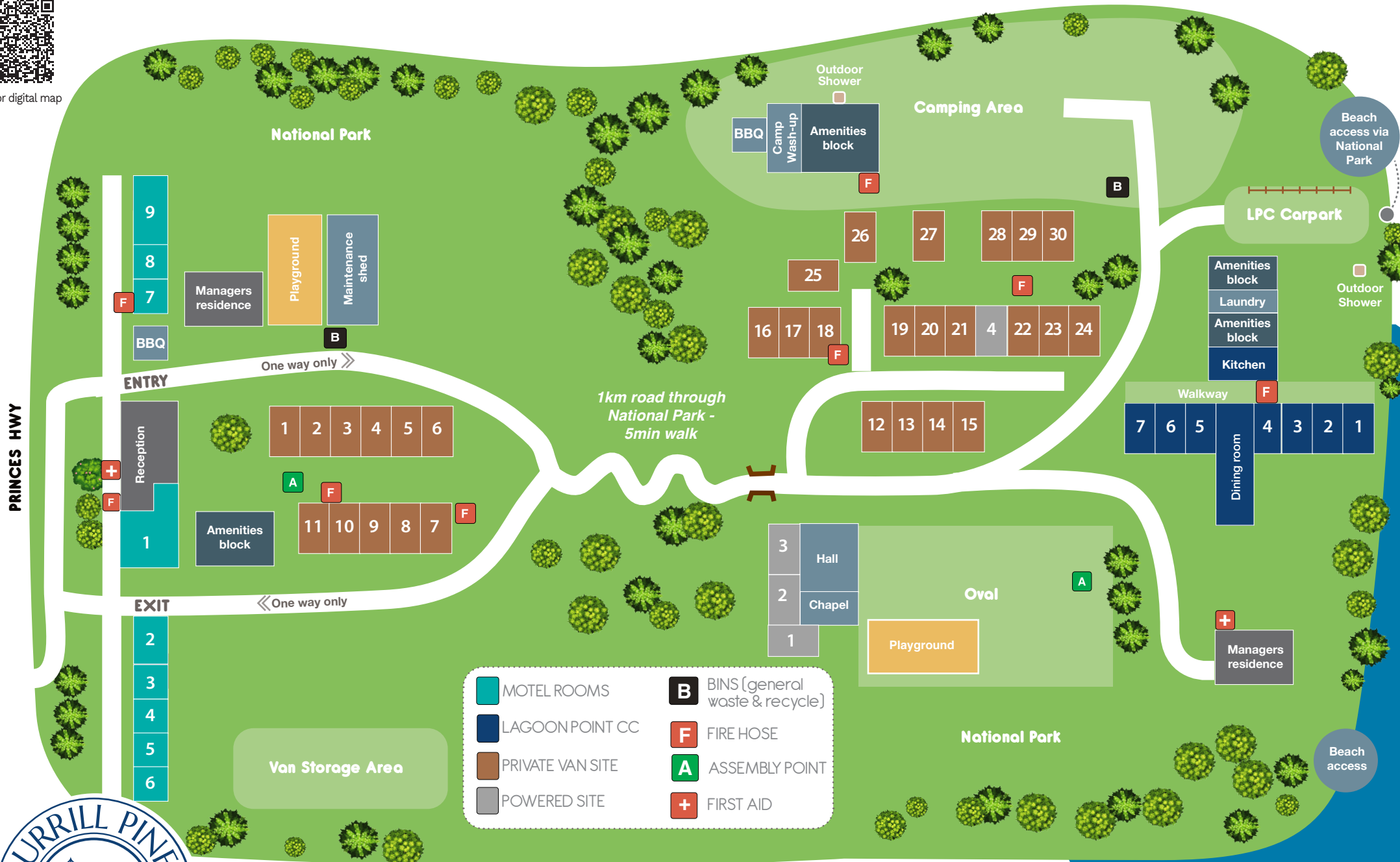


Burrill Pines endeavours to provide a peaceful and relaxing environment for everyone within our park. With this in mind we ask all guests to please note the following:

- Be considerate: Please be considerate of other guests' right to a pleasant stay.
- Respect property: Be respectful of all park property. All breakages must be paid for.
- Anti-social behaviour: Drunk, disorderly, anti-social behaviour and offensive language will not be tolerated.
- Speed limit: Strictly 20km/hr on access road connecting Conference Centre and motel area. In all other areas of the park the roads are a shared traffic zone and motorists are restricted to WALKING PACE ONLY.
- Smoking: Smoking is not permitted in or around the buildings.
- Pets: Burrill Pines is a pet free environment.
- Noise levels: We don't allow loud music at any time and no loud noise after 10pm. For the comfort of all our guests, our quiet period is between 10pm - 7am. If there is unsatisfactory noise levels, contact management for assistance.
- Cooperation with staff: We ask that all guests cooperate with staff direction. Staff reserve the right to ask guests to leave the premises if unwilling to adhere to the conditions of entry in our park.
- Check In/out: Check in time is from 2pm to close. **After hours Check In must be organised during office hours or charges may apply.** Check out time is 10am unless otherwise approved/pre arranged with the office.
- Visitors: Visitors must check in at the office and obtain a visitor's pass before entering. The visitor's pass is \$5 per guest.
